

THEODOR'S HISTORY

Originally founded in 1959 as a school for children in the Jewish Community of Port Elizabeth, the Theodor Herzl School was named after the respected author - who also inspired the school motto - "if you will it, it is no dream".

Our campus is securely located in the park-like suburb of Walmer, where we now house the pre-primary school, the primary school and the high school on one campus.

Our school provides a vibrant, multicultural community in which they can and do learn respect, tolerance and humanity. The diverse learning community is a wonderful environment in which our students are able to learn important social, coping and life skills.

At the core of all our efforts, our staff, students and community of parents, are committed to our ethos of solid values and excellence.

THE PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOL

Theodor Herzl Pre-Primary offers a warm, nurturing environment maintained by professional staff who are highly qualified Foundation Phase teachers, who have specialised in Early Childhood Development (ECD). Boys and girls between the ages of 3 and 6+ enjoy happy, constructive days as they develop from grade 000 to grade 0 in preparation for the demands of formal schooling.

We pride ourselves on fostering independence and group interaction while still focusing on the unique and individual needs of our children. Universal beliefs, values and attitudes are the vital life skills that we continue to instil in our children, as they are essential to their future endeavours.

Our programme is designed to awaken a desire to learn by stimulating curiosity and creativity. We strive to create positive experiences of schooling so that learning becomes a continued joyful experience. Our superbly equipped facilities include resource-rich classrooms and an exceptional playground that offers children the optimal environment in which to learn, grow and develop. Early intervention is key and both occupational and speech therapy are offered on site within the school day.

A typical school day includes the following within a structured routine: 07H40 : Arrival at school 08H00 - 08H20 : Big Ring 08H20 - 08H40 : Outdoor Play 08H40 - 09H00 : Morning Ring 09H00 - 09H40 : Creative Activities 09H40 - 10H00 : Free Play 10H00 - 10H20 : Music / Movement / Drama / Conversational Xhosa / Kinderkinetics 10H20 : Snack Time 10H40 - 11H10 : Free Play : Pack-up Time 11H15 11H20 - 11H40 : Quiet Indoor Play 11H40 : Story 12H00 : Home Time

This structured routine meets and exceeds the National Curriculum requirements of literacy, numeracy and life skills. These learning experiences as well as free play are critical in providing opportunities for physical, social, cognitive and creative development, including time management, problem solving and promotion of emotional intelligence.

Regular class excursions to exciting child-friendly facilities further enrich the children's experiences every term. A convenient aftercare facility is available from 12H00 to 17H00. Optional extramural activities are offered on site and these include Soccercize Starz, Monkeynastix, Playball, Kinderkinetics, Creative Dance, Experibuddies and Sandula Kids.


