SCHOOL FEES FOR THE YEAR 2026

As is customary at this time of the year, the Financial Sub-committee of the Board of Governors has conducted a detailed process to establish the required annual adjustment in school fees for the upcoming year.

After a comprehensive assessment and in light of the current economic circumstances, we have re-adjusted the school fees for the upcoming academic year. The difficult financial climate in which we all exist has been uppermost in our thinking, strategizing and planning.

It goes without saying that we are and remain, committed to providing the same high-quality education and support for which Theodor Herzl Schools is known. Our dedicated teaching and administrative staff continue to work tirelessly to ensure that your child/ren receive the best possible education and opportunities for growth.

It is important to know what our school fees include. In many cases, our offerings are considered extras (paid for by parents) at other schools. Not at Theodor Herzl Schools. These inclusive services and offerings are reflected at the end of the school-fee schedule. We strive to ensure that our school fees are a "one-stop shop." What you see on the schedule is what you are eligible to pay. There are no unexpected "pop-ups" with regard to monthly fees.

I thank our Chairman of the Finance Committee, Mr Alan Goldberg and our Bursar, Mrs Ingrid Carter-Raine, for their unfailing support along with the careful and prudent manner in which they handle the finances of our School.

After careful consideration, we would like to advise you that the school fees and enrolment fees for 2026 are:

ENROLMENT AND ADMINISTRATION FEES

High School:	R10 000.00 deposit upon acceptance with R9 000.00 refundable in the first year
Primary School	R6 000.00 deposit upon acceptance with R5 000.00 refundable in the first year
Pre-primary School	R5 000.00 deposit upon acceptance with R4 000.00 refundable in the first year

NOTICE PERIOD ON TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

A term's notice is required before removing a pupil or changing a pupil's enrolment status. If the required notice is not given, a term's fees in lieu of notice will be payable and charged to the scholar's account.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

The following payment options are available:

1. STANDARD OPTION

The annual fee paid in 4 equal instalments at the beginning of each term. Should this option be chosen, payment is required by the end of the first week of each term.

2. ADVANCE PAYMENT OPTION

The annual fee paid in a single instalment on or before the 31 January 2026, in which case a 5,00% discount will be allocated.

3. INSTALMENT PAYMENT OPTION:

DEBIT ORDER (Forms available on request)

The annual fee paid in 11 equal monthly instalments in the form of a debit order processed as follows:

- 12 instalments falling due either on 15th or 31th (one date of your choice) of each month from January to December 2026 or
- 11 instalments falling due either on 1st of each month from February to December 2026

ELECTRONIC TRANSFER

The annual fee paid in 12 equal instalments transferred directly into the nominated bank account as follows:

- 12 instalments falling due by the beginning of each month from January to December 2026.
